

## INTRODUCTION

The WUHD-MR300 is a wireless presentation kit with 1 Base unit 2 WUHD-MRTX It allows up to 16 WUHD-MRTX connect to Base-Unit simultaneously and, with maximum 9 users sharing at a time. User can share content from their laptops ormobile devices on a large meeting room screen in a very simple waywithout cables and additional configuration, just by clicking the button and airplay for iPhone. It makes meeting more efficient and productive.

# **FEATURES**

## PC/MAC Compatible

 The WUHD-MRTX is for both Windows PC and Apple Mac, which communicating with Base-Unit.

#### **Android APP**

Provided to share content on Android mobile devices.

# Airplay

Screen mirroring supports iOS devices without using an app.

#### 2.4G/5G

Supports 2.4G or 5G wireless transmission.

# **Long Wireless Transmission Distance**

 The wireless transmission distance without obstacle up to 30m (98ft) between WUHD-MRTX and Base-Unit.

#### Wireless AP

 Built-in Wi-Fi access point to set up a standalone Wi-Fi network between PC-sources/mobile devices and the Base-Unit.

#### **LAN-Network**

 Additional LAN port on Base-Unit, to link mobile devices to a LAN network or internet whilst being connected to the Base-Unit over Wi-Fi.




# SYSTEM CONNECTION DIAGRAM DESCRIPTION



Before wiring, disconnect the power supplies of all the devices.

#### To the MR-Pad device:

- 1. Install the antenna on the antenna interface of the main engine.
- 2. The LAN port is connected to the internet.
- 3. AUDIO OUT is connected to the speaker.
- 4. HDMI OUT is connected to the HDMI input port of the display device.
- The VGA OUT is connected to the VGA input port of the display device.
- 6. USB port for pairing MR-Pad.
- 7. Connect the power adapter to the DC power port.
  - Note: When all set, check the LED indicators. For LED indication, please refer to page 06/08.

#### WUHD-MRTX

#### PAIRED WITH THE HOST DEVICE:

Using the device before for the first time ,The WUHD-MRTX should be paired with host devices. The operation is as follows :

- 1. Insert the WUHD-MRTX into the host's USB jack ,and the WUHD-MRTX indicator light turns blue.
- 2. After waiting for 10 senconds ,the indicator light starts flashing. When it turns red ,the pairing is done.
- 3. Pull out the WUHD-MRTX device and the pairing is completed. (The whole pairing takes about 15 senconds.)

#### WINDOWS USERS:

**STEP 1:** Connect the WUHD-MRTX to the computer's USB port and the computer will display the USB disk name: MR



**STEP 2:** When you first use it, manually open the MR.exe program in the usb flash disk, and WUHD-MRTX begins to connect with the host (The program will run automatically after the second use).



STEP 3: Wait for the LED light on the WUHD-MRTX to turn into a constant blue light. Click the button on the WUHD-MRTX to project the screen.(At this point, the LED light on the WUHD-MRTX will turn red, indicating that the screen is being cast.)







Note: The WUHD-MRTX has been paired with the host machine before delivery. If the screen casting is not successful, please manually match

Pairing method: connect the WUHD-MRTX to the host's USB port and wait for about 10 seconds. If the indicator light on the WUHD-MRTX is always on, the pairing will be successful.

#### **MAC OS USERS:**

STEP 1: Insert WUHD-MRTX into your MAC OS computer

**STEP 2:** For the first time, you need to run MR applications on MAC OS.

**STEP 3:** When you first use WUHD-MRTX, you need to manually open the "U disk" and click to run the MR.app application software. The system prompts the user of the current system to use the password.

**STEP 4:** When you use WUHD-MRTX again, you do not need to run the MR APP software again. There is no need to enter the user system password again.



## **USE AFTER EQUIPMENT IS READY:**

When the LED light on the WUHD-MRTX turns blue and the computer screen appears "button connected to the host computer successfully, can be shared", press the button on the WUHD-MRTX to put the contents of the computer onto the display; after sharing, the WUHD-MRTX indicator turns red; press the WUHD-MRTX button again to exit the sharing interface.



#### **IPAD / IPHONE USERS:**

**STEP 1:** Select VisualSpace-XXXXX device in wireless LAN to establish network connection.(Initial password is 12345678)



STEP 2: Use screen mirroring



STEP 3: Select VisualSpace-XXXXX device and click to project the screen



#### **ANDROID USERS:**

STEP 1: Scan the gr code, download and install the MR Configuration





**STEP 2:** Select VisualSpace\_XXXXX device in wireless LAN to establish network connection.(Initial password is 12345678)





**STEP 3:** Open the MR.APP and click the VisualSpace\_XXXXX device to cast the screen . (The mirror screen has no sound, and the local audio and video screen has sound)





#### **WEB SET:**

**STEP 1:** Use the computer or mobile terminal to connect to the WiFi of the host. Enter the WiFi IP in the browser (Google is recommended) and enter the login interface.

STEP 2: User name: admin; Password: admin



#### Note:

- 1. Web page login IP address: https://192.168.118.1
  - 2. The PC terminal WiFi must be connected to the same WiFi on the host.



**STEP 3:** The output resolution of the host, wiFi name and password, 2.4g /5G frequency band, signal channel, network setting, etc. Can be modified



Note:

The main machine has the function of wire bridge and wireless bridge

When the host's wired network port or wireless network card is connected to the Internet, the phone or tablet can be connected to the host hot spot, and the screen can be projected and the Internet can be accessed.

# Q1. The Computer screens can't be shared.

- Press WUHD-MRTX button and share the screen when the red light is on.
- Press WUHD-MRTX button, blue light on the screen exit;

## Q2. The screen cannot be displayed.

 The equipment needs to be newly matched. When the following situations shall be re-matched: Software upgrade; Make the Settings change to the Web; Dial keys need to be used with other machines.

### O3. Unable to connect

 The computer inserted the button, the blue light flickered for a long time, and the screen was always connected to the dialog box, just plug the button into the host USB port to be re-matched.

# Q4. Screen can not be projected.

 when the computer enters the lock screen state, the screen cannot be cast, and the button displays blue light.

# Q5. Connection and screen instability problem.

Check the surrounding WiFi environment by installing the WiFi analyzer on android phones to see whether there are more WiFi disturbances (try not to more than 3 sources on one channel) and whether the WiFi signal strength of the host is sufficient (at least to be stable greater than -70dbm). If there is more interference, Then login host WEB to modify channels (5G frequency band has 9 channels to choose from, it is recommended to use 5G instead of 2.4g) to a relatively idle channel. If the signal strength is weak, then look at where the host is placed and move the host until the signal strength is stable greater than -70dbm.
